Finnish residents enthusiastic about cruises in February 2011

In February cruises to Estonia and Sweden were very popular among Finnish residents. The number of cruises grew by 36 per cent from last year's February, while the number of leisure trips with overnight stay to Estonia and Sweden fell by 25 per cent. The number of domestic leisure trips with overnight stay increased by five per cent. One fifth of these trips were made to the region of Uusimaa.


Finnish residents' overnight leisure trips in February 2011 and annual change, preliminary data

In February Finnish residents made 442,000 overnight leisure trips abroad. In all, 230,000 of them included one or more overnights in the country of destination, twenty per cent in Estonia and eight per cent in Sweden. Most of the cruises including overnights on board only were to Sweden and Estonia.

Finnish residents made 2.3 million leisure trips in Finland. This is 4 per cent down on the corresponding period in the year before. Most of the trips, or 1.8 million, included free accommodation at one's own free-time residence, with relatives or friends or in some other type of free accommodation.

These preliminary data are based on Statistics Finland's Finnish Travel Survey for which 1,469 persons aged 15 to 74 permanently resident in Finland were interviewed in March.

The final annual data on the Finnish Travel Survey are published on the homepage of the statistics in June following the statistical reference year.
